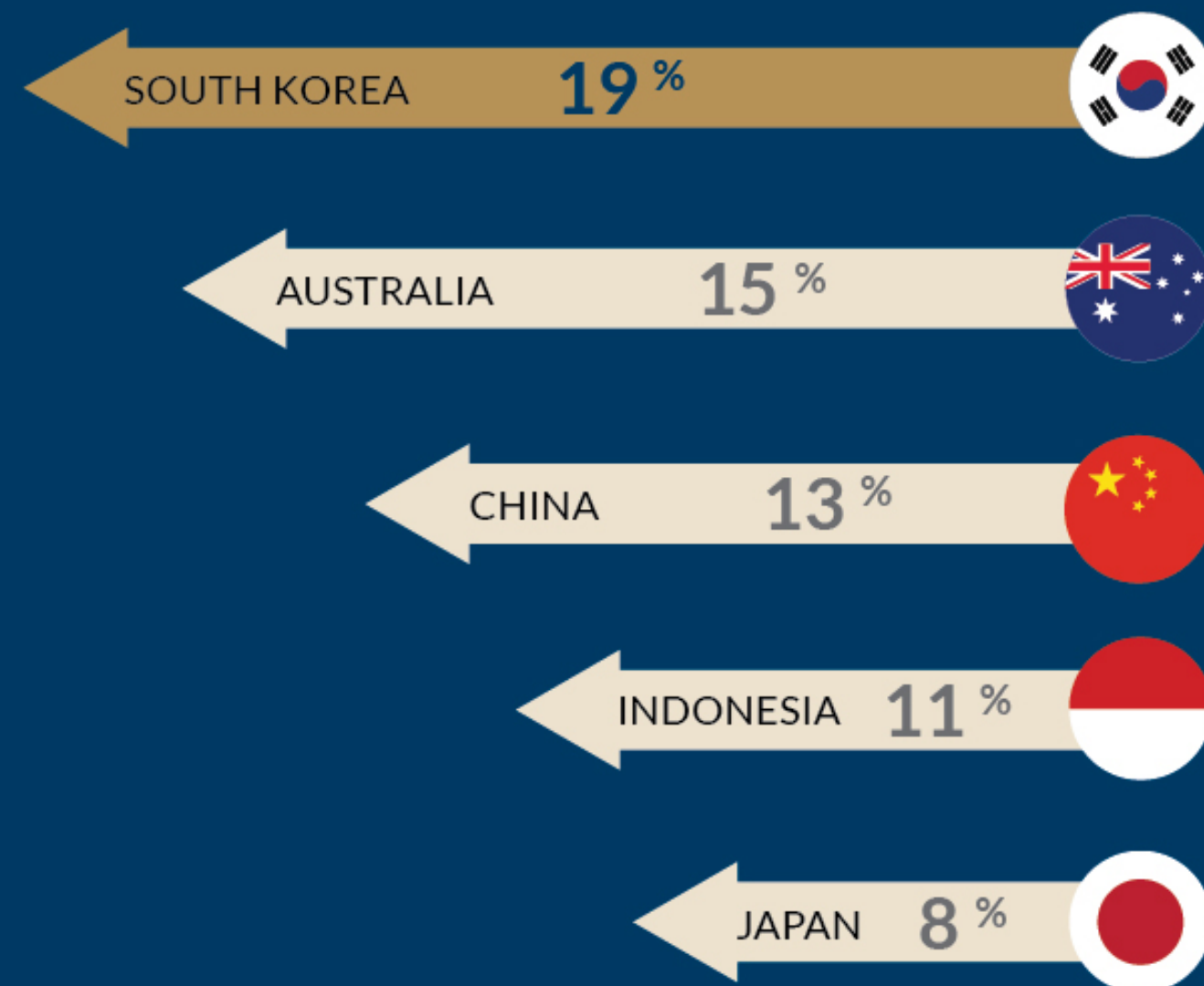
Top 5 Export Commodities



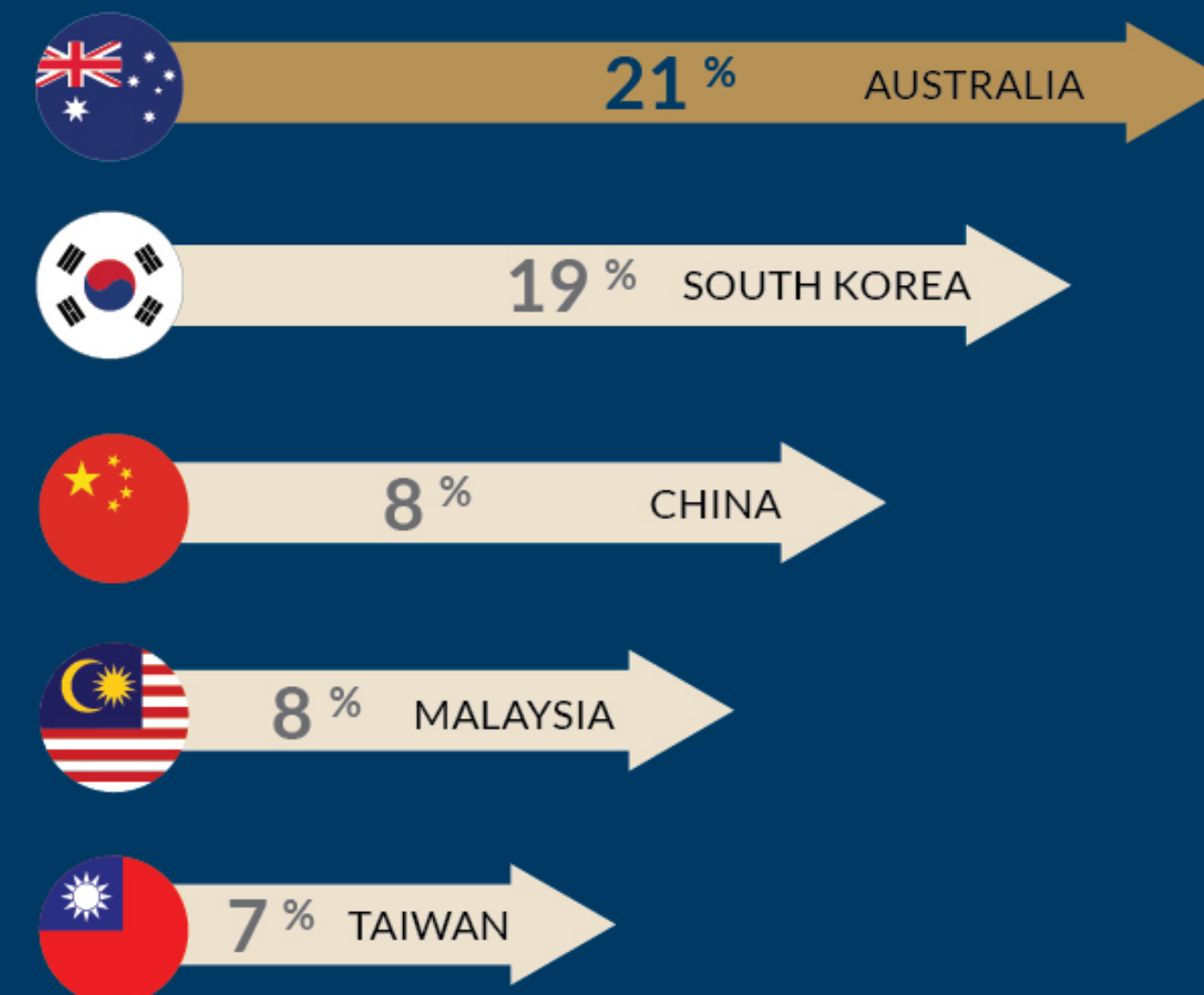

Top 5 Export Destinations

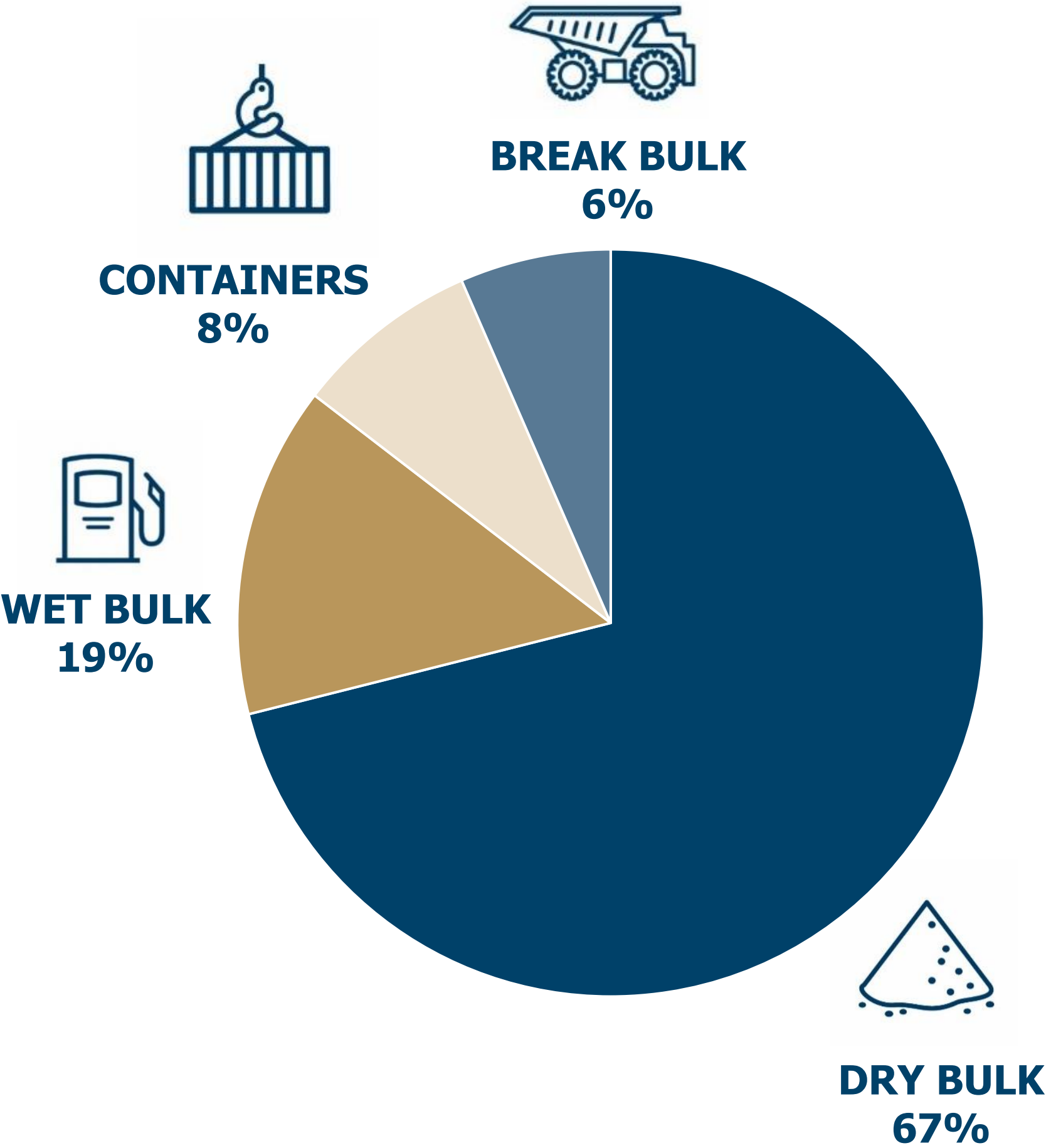
