

Grant Objectives

The purpose and objectives of the EET Grant is to assist students in undertaking their university/college qualifications by way of financial assistance for associated workshops, field trips, educational site visits, careers education, short courses/guest lecturers or other minerals related and educational activities.

Funding can only be provided within New Zealand. The key guidelines are that the funding is "minerals related" and purely "educational" in nature. Activities seeking grant funding should not be "member-only" activities.

Grants

Application Guidelines:

Students or student groups (or their supervisors on the students behalf) applying for grant funding should prepare a written application and email it to the Secretary, New Zealand Branch Education Endowment Trust (contact details in the footer of this page) with the following information:

- Purpose, goals or objectives of funding;
- Budget & amount being applied for (if less than the budget amount);
- Name(s) of the individuals/organisations who are requesting the funding;
- Date by which funding is required & date(s) of the event, course or field trip.

Funding is generally by way of Grant based on the Trustees assessment criteria of the project, event, course, field trip, etc. Funding may be in full or a partial amount. The EET reserves the right to accept or decline any Grant funding application at the sole discretion of the Trustees.

All Grant money must be solely used for the designated activity/event and not for other purposes. Non-educational events and expenses, e.g. social gatherings, will not be funded.
