



8 mistakes to avoid for JORC Code compliance

The JORC Code has 3 core principles: materiality, competence and transparency. Transparency requires sufficient information, clear and unambiguous, to understand the report and to not mislead, either intentionally or by omission of Material information that is known to the Competent Person.

Despite this, certain terms and phrases have been known to appear in Public Reports. The following terms are misleading. Some are not JORC Code terminology and others imply the Joint Ore Reserves Committee has approved the resource estimate when it has not.

8 misleading terms to avoid in your Public Report

- 1. In situ value
- 2. JORC-compliant resource
- 3. Mining reserves
- 4. Probable resources
- 5. In-ground value
- 6. Mining inventory
- 7. Hypothetical reserves
- 8. JORC Code compliant estimate
