Connecting communities

We welcomed a record 3,100 new members and now represent over 16,000 resources professionals, including 500 long-standing members who have been part of AusIMM for more than 50 years. We also welcomed more than 1000 Student members embarking on exciting careers in the resources sector.

Advancing careers

We advanced careers through five major technical conferences, including our Underground Operators Conference – the largest in AusIMM history.
